In particular, the website team Rahla Dusheiko , Kylie Bailie, Nicole Keddie and Kathleen Powell have done an enormous amount of work. This work is done on top of their usual jobs. The new website developer in Auckland has progressed to the design stage. Before it came to this there was a lot of discussion on what the website needed to provide. It will help promote Iyengar yoga, support the association events, provide a platform to support our students and teachers find a class near them, support the bookshop, hold reports, meeting minutes, ethics etc. Content from the old site has been taken out and/or rewritten for the new website.
