A&TT Committee

Currently has 5 full members: Suzi Carson (JI3/L3), Wendy Norwood (Chair, JI3/L3), Clare Davenport (JI2/L2), Tamar Munch (JI2/L2), Wendy Purdon (JI1/L2), Stephanie Anderson (JI1/L2)

Earlier this year our most senior members, Susie Lever and Rosie Holland, stepped down from A&TT. Our thanks go to both of them for their experience, generosity with their time, and all their hard work and contribution to the smooth running of A&TT.

Clare Davenport will be stepping into the role of Chair of A&TT from September 2021, replacing Wendy Norwood who has completed a 1 year tenure as Chair.

New Level 1 Assessors

We would like to congratulate Jo Peden and Eira Kramer who have completed their assessor training, and are now qualified to assess at the new Level 1.

A further 3 trainee assessors will sit in on their first Level 1 assessment in November.

Assessments

2020 Assessments - Due to the worldwide Covid-19 pandemic, all assessments for 2020 were postponed until later in the year.

We were able to reschedule, and hold 2 assessments in the old system:

- Introductory - November 2020 – 7 candidates, all passed
- JI3 - November 2020 – 3 candidates resitting JI3, all passed

2021 Assessments -

- Two JI3 assessments were held in 2021, these being the last assessments under the old system:
 - The first JI 3 Assessment 2021 took place in March at the Ponsonby Community Centre, Auckland – 3 candidates sat and all 3 passed.
 - The second JI 3 Assessment took place in May at Herne Bay Iyengar Yoga Centre, Auckland – 3 candidates sat, 2 candidates passed.
- The first Level 1 assessment under the new guidelines is planned for November 5 – 7, 2021 at IYC in Auckland. This will be a busy assessment with 8 candidates sitting.

Future assessments – A&TT are currently planning to hold the first Level 2 assessment in 2022.

The next Level 1 assessment is scheduled for 2023.

We are watching with interest how Australia is proceeding with assessments in an online capacity. This could be an option for our association in the future, acknowledging that the technical requirements would involve much organisation and on-going support.

Covid-19 Situation

This created a few hiccups where A&TT needed to reschedule assessments, some at the last minute due to the lockdowns in 2020. Thanks to everyone for their patience and help here.
