

Assessment and Teacher Training Committee Report

A&TT Committee:

Until recently the A&TT committee had 6 members: Suzi Carson, Wendy Norwood, Clare Davenport, Tamar Munch, Wendy Purdon and Stephanie Anderson.

Resignations have been received from Wendy Norwood, Tamar Munch and Wendy Purdon.

Clare Davenport is stepping down as Chair and also leaving A&TT from the AGM

She will be replaced by Melodie Batchelor as Chair.

Also joining A&TT from the AGM are: Monica Haar, Eira Kramer and Fran Campbell

A&TT would like to thank Wendy Norwood for her 4 years on the committee (significantly 1 year as Chair in 2021), Wendy Purdon for her work as Assessment Coordinator during difficult Covid times, and especially Tamar Munch who has done an enormous amount of work in her role of secretary to bring the assessment application process online, and streamline many of A&TT's processes. It is possible that the role of secretary with its increased demands will become a paid one in the future.

Assessments:

The Level 1 assessment originally scheduled for November 2021 was postponed until February 2022 due to Covid restrictions.

Held on 25/26 February, significantly, it was the first assessment for IYNZ under the new guidelines.

6 candidates sat and passed.

One candidate was prevented from sitting because of vaccination passport requirements.

The next Level 1 assessment will be held in May 2023.

The first Level 2 assessment under the new guidelines will be held in 4-6 November 2022.

There will be 3 candidates.
