TCH and CPM Hand Books

After canvassing the All Assessors Group to read through the TCH and CPM (Hand Books) to check the changes effecting New Zealand, there was nil response.

We wondered whether it was the time of year or lack of time and interest.

Moni and Anne-Marie have been working on the documents and have taken out page 19 of TCH "Naming of Schools and Institutes" and replaced it with the New Zealand All Assessors rules for the above. Moni is also working on draft number 2 to present at this year's AA Meeting, which will contain amendments from Australia and more.

Pranayama Calling for Assessments

Moni states that Australia calls the Pranayama for Assessment. Melodie states that the Moderator calls in NZ as well. The calling of the Pranayama has yet to be passed and included in their manual regarding that it is the Moderator only that should call the Pranayama. Australian Certification Committee Chair and trips to RIMYI
